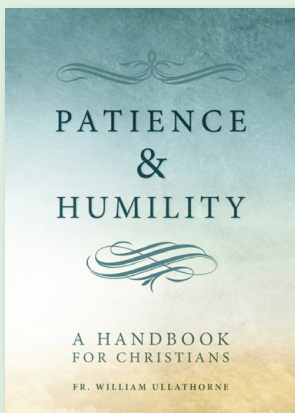

TRIDUUM SERVICES IN HONOR OF ST ANNE AND ST JOACHIM Monday July 23 through Thursday July 26 - St Michael Parish in Cranford will be conducting the annual Triduum in honor of St Anne and St Joachim, the parents of Mary and grandparents of Jesus. On Monday evening (July 23), a candlelight procession to the special shrine containing the Icon of these saints will proceed the Evening Prayer Service in their honor. On Tuesday & Wednesday nights the Triduum will continue with a Prayer Service each evening. On Thursday the feast of St Anne and St Joachim, a Special Feast Day will be conducted for this feast followed with the "Blessing of the Gifts" that have been donated to the Babies with AIDS/HIV collection. All services in honor of St Anne and St Joachim will be conducted at 7 PM. Yearly prayer services in honor of these saints have been conducted at St Michael Parish for well over 100 years.
