Role Purpose

The Junior Peer Minister is a high school sophomore or junior who will be responsible for living out their Catholic faith to encourage and invite middle and high school students to have a closer relationship with Jesus Christ as his disciples.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Junior Peer Minister will perform the following functions:

- Work with the Youth Ministry team to assist during different programs and events as needed for middle and/or high school students
- Welcome students at programs and events
- Help create a safe space for students and connect with them during program activities
- Invite students to opportunities for worship, socializing, and service
- Empower and engage other students to live out their faith
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

Some qualifications required for the position:

- Practicing and Confirmed Roman Catholic
- A positive role-model and witness to a life of faith
- Maturity
- Motivation to serve and minister to students
- Complete a Youth Code of Conduct

Considerations

Some items to be considered for this position:

- Service Hours offered
- High School programs take place on Sunday Nights
- Middle School programs take place on select Weekday Nights
- Flexible schedule, but individuals need to commit to helping with either the High School or Middle School programs
- Skills development offered
