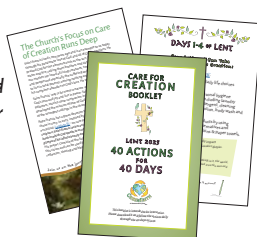


DAYS 29-34 OF LENT

Six Actions I Can Take to Care for God's Creation:

1. Read Chapter 6 of *Laudato Si' & Laudate Deum*.
2. Avoid polluting modes of transportation – walk or bike more – drive less; increase use of public transportation.
3. Support efforts to protect and promote biodiversity and start at home by planting native plants and minimizing or eliminating pesticide use.
4. Practice sustainable lawn care or replace lawns with other types of gardens (rain garden, pollinator garden, rock garden, native garden, etc).
5. Plant native trees to shade the home. Shade is the cheapest way to cool your house.
6. Be aware and support natural areas such as marshes and forests which serve as “carbon sinks” that absorb carbon dioxide in the atmosphere; urban parks – especially those with abundant tree cover – which provide much-needed shade, reduce the “heat island effect,” and have the extra benefit of creating places for recreation and community gatherings.
